Friendly Reminders

To help keep our community looking its best! Please keep these tips in mind:

- Please remove your trash and recycling bins from the curb following your scheduled pickup.
- Please turn off your hose spigots and disconnect your hose when not in use during the winter months to prevent them from freezing and cracking. A cracked or damaged spigot has the potential to cause water damage to the interior of the home.
- Holiday decorations must be taken down within 14 days of the holiday.
- The exterior of homes must be kept clean and clutter-free. Store items not being used in the garage or storage room.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

- If you have a maintenance ticket for your heat or AC, please call in your ticket to ensure a prompt response from the maintenance department by calling (252) 501-2511, option 1.
- When the temperature is below 55 degrees outside, and there is a loss of heat in the home, it is considered an **Emergency Request**, and maintenance will respond within one hour.
- When the temperature is above 55 degrees outside, and there is a loss of heat in the home, it is considered an **Urgent Request**, and maintenance will respond within 4 hours.
- Do not flush wipes down the toilet or pour grease down the sink.
- Please run water while using your garbage disposal. If you are unsure about what can be put in the garbage disposal, simply throw it in the trash.
- Please change the air filter in the HVAC system every 30 days. Filters can be picked up at the Grants Landing Community Office on base at 494 Wilson Dr or off base at the Slocum Community Office at 102 Bern St.
