

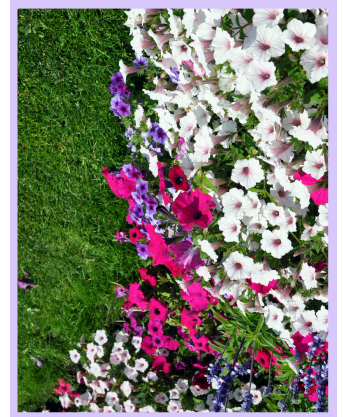

## WHAT CAN I DO TO PREVENT SEWER BACKUPS?

Flush **ONLY** toilet paper!

Fats, oils and greases are bad for sewers. When washed down the sink, grease sticks to the insides of sewer pipes on your property and the pipelines under the street. Over time, it can build up, harden into a plug and block an entire pipe, causing sewer overflows and backups. Home garbage disposals do not keep grease out of the plumbing system. Detergents that claim to dissolve grease may pass the grease down the pipeline and cause problems elsewhere.

Scrape grease and food scraps into a can or the trash for disposal. When you have a greasy pan to wash, wipe it out after use (while it is still warm, not hot) with newspaper or paper towels. Put baskets/strainers in sink drains to catch food scraps and other solids, and then empty them in the trash.

While trash such as baby diapers, plastics and even cigarette filters and chewing gum may seem to disappear when flushed down the toilet, they can form a messy mass and clog your plumbing system and BJWSA pipelines. The result? Sewage back-ups that can be unhealthy for you and the environment. The toilet is **NOT** a trashcan – never flush down anything but **TOILET PAPER**.



### DO NOT FLUSH

- Fats, oils or grease
- Any "flushable" wipes
- Feminine hygiene products
- Chemicals and cleaning rags



## TRASH, RECYCLE, AND BULK SCHEDULE

Trash is collected on a weekly basis at each community under the following schedule. Please ensure that your provided trash container is placed outside your home in the approved location after 6:00 PM on the day preceding trash collection or prior to 7:00 AM on the day of collection. Once the trash is collected, please return your trash container to your backyard or garage by 8:00 PM on the same day as collection. During weeks with holiday closures, trash is collected per the **Holiday Trash Collection Schedule** provided below.
