Recreational Vehicle, Trailer, and Boat Lot Rules

Hunt Military Communities (HMC) offers designated space for the storage of recreational vehicles (RVs), boats, non-motorized campers, and trailers for residents. The following rules and regulations must be adhered to at all times while these items are stored in the lot.

- Space availability is on a first-come, first-served basis and is limited to current HMC residents and Service Members assigned through the base.
- All residents who register for the RV lot will receive a key code to access the lot as needed.
- All RVs, trailers, and/or boats stored in the lot must have valid tags and inspections. If an item does not meet this requirement, HMC will request the resident to remove the item and return the key. If the item is not removed, HMC reserves the right to have it towed. A copy of the valid inspection must be submitted with the registration form.
- All approved items stored in the lot must display the assigned HMC decal.
- Residents may not store items for other service members, friends, or family. The lot is exclusively for HMC residents and service members assigned through the base.
- Miscellaneous or unauthorized items are not allowed in the lot. Items will be removed at the owner's expense.
- When a resident moves out of HMC housing or barracks, all items stored in the lot must be removed by the day of the final move-out inspection. At this time, the key code will be disabled.
- HMC reserves the right to tow any non-compliant items at the resident's expense.
- HMC is not responsible for any damage, theft, or loss of personal property or vehicles while stored on premises.
