MAINTENANCE TIPS

Do your part to keep a handle on pests and critters. It is very important that we practice effective and frequent trash and waste management. Please ensure you are removing waste from your home weekly on scheduled trash days. Waste left to pile up is a haven for many insects and with warmer weather insight trash left outside can invite wildlife. Please ensure you stay on top of your trash and waste removal. After pickup, please ensure your waste bins are returned to their proper storage location.



SAFETY TIPS

The weather is getting warmer and that means more time spent outdoors. Maybe you are planning a fire pit night or grilling night. At Hunt, we want you to enjoy these moments with your family but safely. Please be cognizant and always maintain your grill or fire. Place grills and pits on flat surfaces and maintain a minimum of 15 feet from any structure or foliage. Never leave a grill or fire pit unattended. Ensure there is a method as near as possible to extinguish in the event of an emergency. Remember having a grill or firepit is ultimately your responsibility. By following a few easy safety tips, we can ensure everyone's safety and wellness.
