COMMUNITY REMINDERS

SAFETY TIPS

Keep your children safe, according to the Consumer Product Safety Commission, approximately 4.5 million children are injured by hazards in the home each year. Parents should teach their children about safety at home, at school, on the playground and while traveling. This includes knowing their address and how to call 9-1-1. Never leave young children unattended.

Some helpful ideas to keep kids safe are:

- Cover all unused electrical sockets and keep electrical cords out of children's reach.
- Install protective padding on the corners of furniture with sharp edges.
- Use safety latches and locks on cabinets and drawers.
- Protect children from dangerous areas. Install safety gates at the tops and bottoms of stairways.
- Secure tall bookcases, televisions, or other pieces that might tip over.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Temperatures are rising outside and it's time to lower those thermostats. We are working through the process of completing our annual preventive maintenance to ensure all AC units perform well for your family all season long. Additionally, how you operate the system can play a pivotal role in your systems longevity and ensure it functions at peak capabilities.

The following tips will greatly assist with this task

- Set and maintain your cold setting at no lower than 68 degrees, setting lower puts extra strain on systems and may cause it to freeze.
- For optimal performance, always set your system to the AUTO position. This allows it to run efficiently,
 adjusting as needed to maintain comfort. Leaving it in the ON or RUN position continuously doesn't allow the
 system to cycle properly, leading to increased humidity levels in your home. Excess humidity can make your
 space feel uncomfortable, create dampness, and even encourage mildew growth. Keeping it in AUTO helps
 regulate moisture and ensures a healthier indoor environment!

Following these tips will greatly add to the ability to keep your home cool and comfortable all summer long.
